Below are descriptions of some of the parts of the *Titanic* and the wreck site. Can you find them all in the word search?

anchor chain—a heavy metal chain attached to the anchor of a ship

anchor crane—a machine used to pick up the anchor of a ship

bow—the front end of a ship

boiler—a large tank in which water is boiled to make steam used to power a ship's engines

capstan—a barrel-shaped machine around which ropes are wrapped; the ropes are used to secure a ship to a dock

cargo crane—a machine used to move freight on a ship

coal—fuel burned to power a ship

crow's nest—an observation tub positioned high on a ship's mast where a lookout stands watch

debris field—the area around a shipwreck that is scattered with parts of the ship

hatch—an opening or doorway on a ship

hull—the main body of a ship

rusticles—hanging pieces of rust that look like icicles

ship's telegraph—a communication station on a ship that sends and receives messages

stern—the rear end of a ship

vent—an opening for air
